# FLA Live Arena Fundraising



SCAN

Parents, family and student (18 & up) may sign up to volunteer together in a concession stand at FLA Live Arena in return FLA Live will make a donation to the Marching Eagles Parent Association of 10% of the total number of concession stand sales.

Funds are then directly applied to the operational budget of the MSD band program and 50 points (equivalent to \$50) issued to each volunteer's band account for every shift worked. Shifts are 4-5 hours on average. A shift may run longer during special events.

Two or three times a year, tips are averaged, divided and applied as points to each volunteer's band account per the number of shifts each worked.

# FLA Live Arena Fundraising



All volunteers must complete online training:

- 1) Florida food handler course (valid for 3 years)
- 2) Responsible vendor alcohol new hire course for staff (tri annual training every 4 months)

Follow the instructions to complete your online training and send a copy of the certificates to **Flalive@Eagleregiment.com**.

Please note that the 2 courses have to be added to the cart individually so that the coupon will work.

This way, when you are asked for the code later, you can just touch to paste it.

Choose the COURSE YOUR MANAGER HAS INSTRUCTED YOU TO TAKE and click Add

If you have been instructed to take more than one course, the purchases must be made separately, in different transactions, to receive the full discount. If you put more than 1 course in your shopping cart, you will be charged for the additional courses.

Click Proceed to Cart (you will not be charged; you will enter code when prompted...) or click on shopping cart on cell phone

Two choices will appear on the screen...Login or Create an Account. If you have not already done so, please create an account.

You will be asked to confirm your location by choosing your country and then your state.

Verify the course title you have chosen is correct and choose Next Step: Checkout

Under payment info, Click Do You Have A Coupon Code so box opens. Enter (paste):

SANZAFI ALIVERY22

Click <u>Apply</u>. Please respect capital letters, spaces, etc. It's case-sensitive. Be sure there is no empty space before the first letter which sometimes happens when pasting.

#### Click Go to Dashboard

While those who have never been on the site will be asked to create a profile, returning learners will simply go to the course they've been enrolled in and click to start.

When creating your profile, you'll be asked what establishment is requiring your training, please specify Sanza FLA Live Arena so we put you on the correct list.

#### Enjoy the course!

Every learner on the site must have their own email address which cannot be shared with others as it is a unique identifier. This code may not be forwarded to or shared with anyone without the express consent of the manager it has been provided to. Unsuthorised use or abuse of this code will result in learners being charged and fewer uses of the code. Thank you for your business.

### **POINTS**



For certain fundraisers, the Marching Eagle Parent Association will offer POINTS as an acknowledgement of participation in the event. A "POINT" may be used to pay for most MSD band program financial obligations.

- MEPA will honor the use of POINTS at a value of 1 point to \$1.00.
- POINTS are not refundable and cannot be redeemed for cash.
- POINTS earned may be exchanged for program dues, travel, store purchases, MSD concert tickets, Indoor Percussion and Winter Guard.
- POINTS earned may NOT be used to purchase other fundraiser items (cheesecake, poinsettias, raffle tickets, coupon books, car wash tickets, etc.)
- POINTS are transferable between siblings participating in the program at the same time or down to a sibling who is entering the program in a consecutive year.
- POINTS will be held in an account only long enough to transfer to a sibling entering the program in a consecutive year. POINTS will not be saved for multiple seasons.
- POINTS will roll-over from one season to the next for those students that continue to be active in the MSD band program.
- POINTS not used by a participant who leaves the MSD band program (via graduation or withdrawal from the program) are forfeited.






### **NYC Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade**

#### **Eagle Regiment Letterman Jacket**




The Stoneman Douglas Eagle Regiment letterman jacket is required for the Macy's trip in November. All students in band and color guard will need to purchase a jacket.
