
London Trip

• Pay by Check

Make your check payable to MEPA. In the notes, write your student's name and purpose of the payment. Place in secure drop box in the band room or mail.

• Credit card

Log in to Charms and click the "Finances" icon (the red \$ sign at the top toolbar).
